The seedbed in motion: The 5th edition is coming

Parque Azulgrana is getting ready to host the 5th edition of the Canteranos de América Tournament. A meeting space designed to boost the development of the youngest athletes through excellence and camaraderie. An experience that transcends the purely sporting realm, generating genuine, human visibility of the highest institutional value.

The Canteranos de América tournament brings together football schools in each edition in a tournament designed for the youngest players: real competition, professional organization, and a celebration for families.



This is an initiative of the Club Cerro Porteño Foundation that has established itself as the premier reference tournament for youth development projects in the region. During the weekends of July 11, 12, 18, and 19, the park's fields will host more than 640 young talents, distributed across 32 teams belonging to 16 football schools, who will be the protagonists on the pitch.

From the field to the classroom...

True to the premise that development must be comprehensive, the tournament expands its boundaries beyond the touchline. This edition will include a series of masterclass lectures aimed at youth coaches in the field, focused on the working methodology implemented by the club in its youth divisions.

These presentations will be delivered by Julio Meza, Youth Football Development Manager of The Best Academy in the Country, offering participating coaches a deep look into the model that has made our institution a regional benchmark. In this way, the CCP Foundation shares knowledge, charting a clear and professional path toward the evolution of grassroots football.

WHEN MANAGEMENT IS MEASURED, This is how our Azulgrana academy advances!

When we took on this challenge, we did so with a clear conviction: Cerro Porteño's greatness is not told, it is demonstrated through work. That is why, with this report, we are excited to bring you this first newsletter with a review of our first four months leading the Academy Project 2026-2028 (period from February 4 to May 31).

This is the reflection of a process backed by real data, official indicators, and tools that are already operating at full capacity at Parque Azulgrana. For us, managing means transforming talent into reality. We set the bar high and the first sporting and institutional results show us we are on the right path:



We look back and see four months of intense effort, but we look ahead and see Cerro Porteño's future consolidating day by day. Thank you for joining us in shaping the next idols of El Ciclón!

- ✓ **Leaders!** We hold first place in the APF Youth Divisions annual standings.
- ✓ **Pure effectiveness:** We achieved an average of 2.66 points per match during this 2026 season.
- ✓ **Constant evolution:** We recorded a cumulative growth of 15.15% compared to 2023 performance.
- ✓ **Elite monitoring:** We have already added 518 players to the institutional monitoring system.

THE 5 PILLARS OF A TRANSFORMATION THAT NEVER STOPS

To build the best academy in the country, we structured our work around five strategic pillars:

1 - Transparency (On track ✓)

We implemented audited accountability mechanisms and a Business Intelligence system for the Presidency. Every financial resource has exact traceability according to its responsible party.



3 - Sustainability (In progress)

We advanced in expense control, economic valuation of our players, and commercial organization through a solid managerial structure.



5 - Innovation (Ahead of schedule ✓)

More than 50 modules of the institutional system are already operational, we completed 319 database migrations, and put into production 83 artificial intelligence agents along with a proprietary video analysis engine.

2 - Training Excellence (Ahead of schedule ✓)

We strengthened scouting as the heart of our sporting model, documented the RTA methodology, and consolidated our own system for projecting footballers toward the First Division.



4 - Cerro Unity (On track ✓)

We developed new digital spaces for players, parents, and sponsors through the "Mi Club" and "Family Portal" platforms, connecting the footballer with their environment more than ever.

CHRONOLOGY OF THE TRANSFORMATION

First the data, then the screen.



For results to show on the pitch, we first focused on achieving the administrative order required by the challenge. The Academy today is sustained by a passionate work team that rose month after month during a four-month period of intense effort.

FEBRUARY

Creation of the intelligent foundations: the AI brain, censuses, the scouting system, the Player360 platform, and—as the absolute priority from day one—the Medical Shield were activated.

MARCH

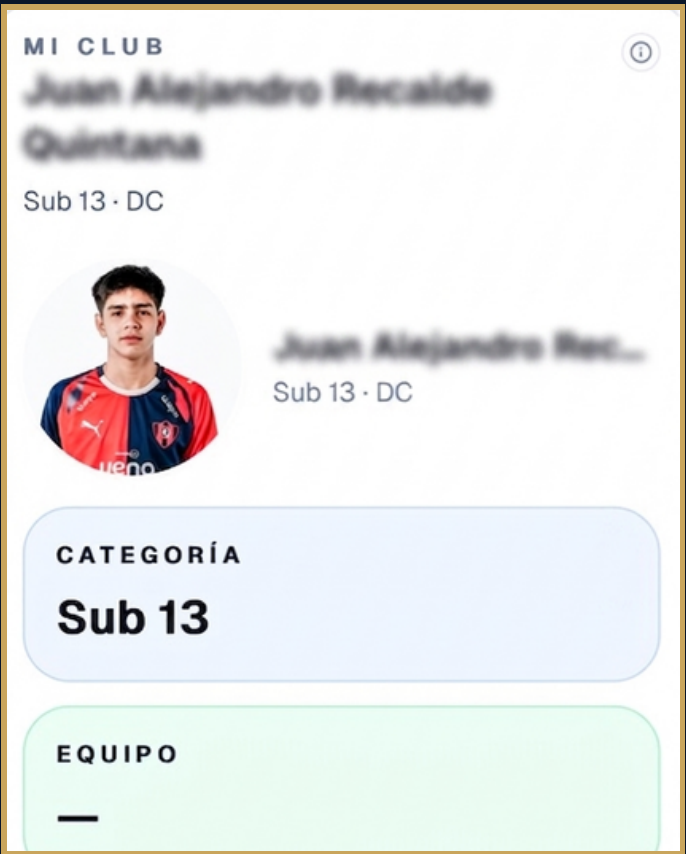
The ecosystem expanded by integrating official APF data, adding market valuation, and including the community through the football school and the family portal. The coaches' space was inaugurated: a central, unified, and technology-driven place to design training sessions, centralize pedagogical knowledge, and elevate their role as elite developers.

APRIL

Focused on the player with the launch of the "Mi Club" portal and video-analysis tools, while institutional management was fortified through contract control, the commercial area, and administration.

MAY

Consolidation of the quality leap with a proprietary video engine, the 5P nutrition program, First Team projection metrics, and a management dashboard for global monitoring.





Workspaces: A place worthy of Cerro, designed for planning and working.

Clear accounts: Today, every guaraní is traceable and goes through auditing. Total transparency.

Controlled nutrition: Reorganization of food processes and expenses, resulting in significant cost savings, increased diners, and improved food quantity/quality.

Our first major decision was about management: administrative order, audited accountability, absolute traceability, and dignified working conditions.

Registered income: Ticket revenue 100% recorded and controlled.

Legal shield: We implemented the Anti-Money Laundering Prevention Manual and the Code of Ethics at the Cerro Porteño Foundation.

Sustainable Football School: Reorganization of the organizational chart, structure, and processes in the Football Schools, leading to financial order and surplus.

THE METHOD

To transform the Academy, we set a non-negotiable rule: **real data first, then technology**. Under this working logic, the revolution advanced strongly through the activation of the **Medical Shield**, the *scouting* system, and the **Player360** single file powered by **Ciclón AI** to centralize every player's life.

The ecosystem was consolidated by connecting to the APF, migrating infrastructure, and enabling the **Family Portal**, the coaches' space, and the economic valuation system. Daily management gained power with the "**Mi Club**" portal for players, **M-025** video analysis, and digital control of finances and contracts.

Finally, we reached the cutting edge by incorporating a GPU-powered video engine, the **5P** nutrition system, the First Team projection module, and an intelligent dashboard for the Presidency, turning innovation into a reality that secures El Ciclón's future.



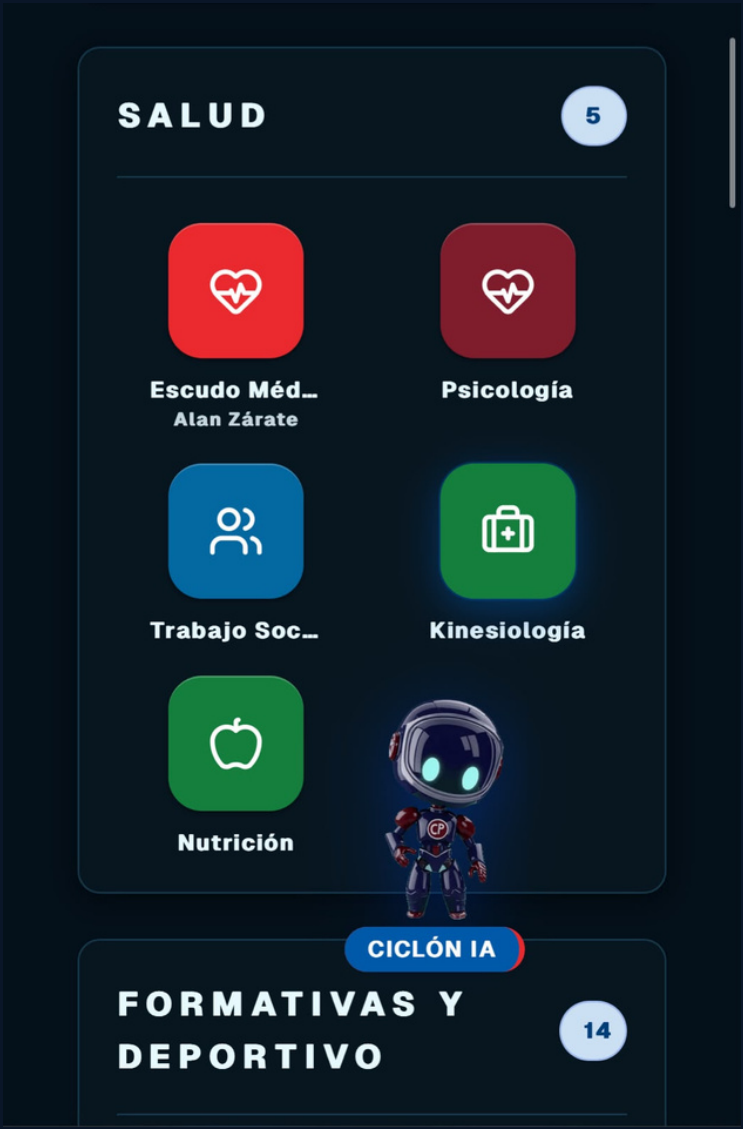
HOW THE AZULGRANA MEDICAL SHIELD OPERATES

As our first major implementation, we launched this comprehensive protection system that now operates permanently, allowing us to monitor every young player's health in real time:

Immediate alert: The player reports a symptom from his phone and an artificial intelligence instantly classifies the severity of the case.

Unified history: The report goes directly to the medical and physiotherapy team, unifying everything in a single digital clinical record.

Zero bureaucracy in the face of risk: If the case is critical, the system bypasses administrative steps and notifies doctors, managers, and directors within seconds through multiple channels.



To safeguard health in the Academy, we unified everything into a single digital file. Through artificial intelligence, the system detects symptoms early and measures the severity of each case. It also unifies the clinical history across all medical areas, includes a traffic-light system to monitor relapse risk, and centralizes all the player's studies in one place.

Honoring Alan's memory means protecting the future of every young player who dreams of wearing our jersey. The Medical Shield is already a reality, safeguarding the soul of our Academy every day.

SCOUTING: MUCH MORE THAN FINDING TALENT

One of the most important changes in our management is how we understand scouting. It is no longer just the initial tryout—it has become the axis that organizes all player development, uniting health, performance, and projection under a single logic. This model enhances the club's historic work by systematizing our professionals' knowledge across three key dimensions:



THE 3 DIMENSIONS OF SCOUTING



Emotional dimension: We analyze the personality, character, and decision-making of each young player through psycho-emotional profiles. We care about the human being behind the athlete.

Physical dimension: We monitor their health, training loads, and anthropometric data in a single comprehensive digital file.

Aptitude dimension: We evaluate their technique, tactics, and potential through a six-axis rubric specific to each position on the field.

With this comprehensive approach, we ensure that every young player receives the exact support they need to unlock their talent and arrive prepared for the First Division.

MORE THAN EVER

The numbers don't lie, and neither does the daily effort. The sporting results from the first stretch of the season reflect the direct impact of our new management model. At the close of Matchday 18 of the APF Youth Divisions Annual Standings, Cerro Porteño looks down on everyone from the top!

This performance consolidates our academy as the youth development structure with the best sporting results in all of Paraguay. A tremendous source of pride!

AN ACADEMY THAT DIDN'T JUST IMPROVE... IT ACCELERATED!

These results are no coincidence. If we look at the average points per match, the evolution speaks for itself:

2023:	2.31 pts/match
2024:	2.33 pts/match
2025:	2.40 pts/match
2026:	2.66 pts/match!

 **What do these numbers mean?** They represent a 10.83% increase over last season and a leap six times greater than the best growth previously recorded. While total growth between 2023 and 2025 was 3.9%, in these first months of 2026 we delivered the biggest surge of the entire period!

The key to success? This takeoff coincides perfectly with the start of the new management and the launch of a comprehensive model that combines data, health, a clear working methodology, and top-level scouting.

This June, 17 footballers from our Academy received the call from the coaching staff led by Ariel Holan and officially began their integration into the select squad that trains alongside the main football team.

This is a great victory for the CCP Foundation, as we seek to support the development of young athletes with discipline and planning, under the firm conviction that daily work opens the doors to every academy player's ultimate goal: reaching the First Division. This step consolidates the constant, comprehensive, and committed effort we carry out every day.

DEVELOPMENT DNA: THE GREATEST VICTORY

Every call-up to the First Team is the greatest victory and the most valuable expression of our development model.

Our priority is to develop footballers prepared to wear the first team's jersey, with the sporting, human, and competitive tools required to represent Cerro Porteño. That is why we understand that every player who takes this step is the best evidence that the project is moving in the right direction.

At the same time, this growth strengthens the entire development process, driving new opportunities for those who continue their development across the different categories and reaffirming a path of permanent evolution.

Because in the Academy we prioritize development and promotion above any circumstantial result. Preparing the future icons and idols of El Ciclón is our goal!



PROJECTION TOWARD THE FIRST DIVISION

One of the main objectives of the Academy is to consolidate a permanent flow of footballers prepared to join the professional squad.

Currently, the system identifies 22 players with projection toward the First Division. The list is built from the official APF census integrated into the CCP ERP institutional system and incorporates information related to performance, sporting development, and national team call-ups, enabling continuous monitoring of each footballer's progress.

Our institutional project has a clear and ambitious roadmap: for 60% of the First Division squad to be made up of footballers developed in our youth divisions. The incorporation of these 17 young players represents a new step toward that

goal and reaffirms the solidity of a project that bets on homegrown talent as the foundation of the club's present and future. Once again, it is proven that when the First Team calls, the Academy answers.

A PROCESS ALREADY BEARING FRUIT

The Academy is the starting point of stories that continue to be written beyond our own categories. Freddy Emanuel Silvero González will continue his professional career on loan at Club 2 de Mayo, carrying with him the mark of a development model that accompanied him from his earliest years as a footballer. Every step toward professionalism is the expression of a process that combines talent, discipline, and comprehensive training built day by day in our Academy,



we continue supporting his development with the full team and technology of The Best Academy in the Country.

With each transfer, the reach of a project that transcends its own limits and contributes to Paraguayan football with players developed with identity, values, and a deep sense of belonging is reaffirmed. That is the legacy we build every day: an academy that not only projects Cerro Porteño's future but also contributes to the growth of national football.

We grew with less, not with more

This sporting leap was not achieved with more resources, but with fewer. In a context of strong budget constraints, performance still rose: methodology, proprietary technology, and discipline.

OUR COMPETITIVE ADVANTAGE

The DNA of the Azulgrana Academy

In modern football, talent is only the starting point; the real difference lies in how it is cultivated. Our great advantage, what makes us unique and difficult to replicate, is the **RTA Methodology** (Adaptive Triangular Reticulation): the master blueprint with which we shape the footballers of the future.

It is a living system, fully digitized and structured. From the U-9 kids to the Reserve youth, the entire academy speaks the same language under one universal principle:



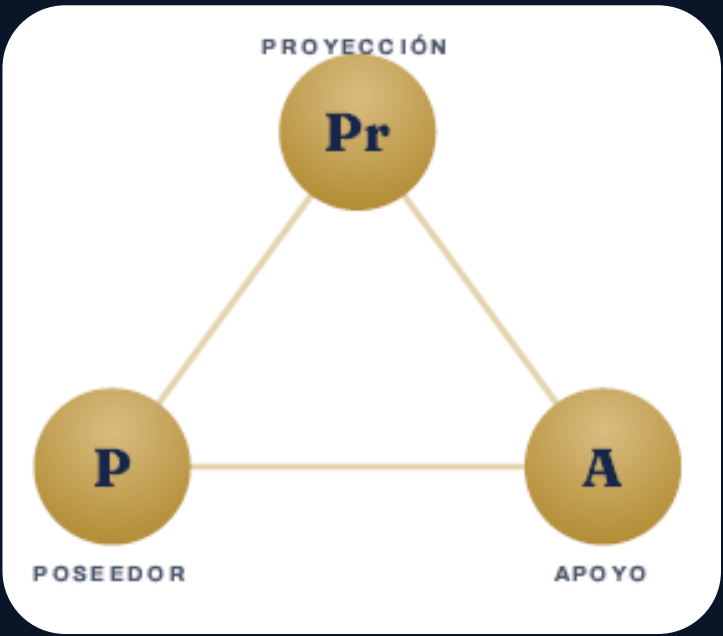
Feel, Read, Decide, and Execute.

THE RTA CELL: THE SECRET IS IN THE TRIANGLE

For us, football is not played in masses, it is played in small ecosystems. The fundamental unit of our style is the triangle, a dynamic structure that adapts to whatever the match demands:

When we attack: The game flows through three key roles: the Possessor, the Support, and the Projection.

When we defend: The mindset switches immediately, but the triangle holds. We organize under the principles of Pressure, Cover, and Space Closure, always maintaining defensive balance (rest defence) as a non-negotiable standard.



THE PLAYER'S 360° DEVELOPMENT

Developing an elite footballer goes far beyond what he does with his feet. That is why we evaluate our players across five comprehensive dimensions: technique, tactics, physical preparation, the psychological aspect, and the specific context of their role on the field.

To measure this growth objectively, we rely on six families of key performance indicators (KPIs) that analyze each phase of the game: from how the team builds from the back, how it progresses,

how it finishes plays, to how it defends, reorganizes, and how each individual performs.

Each player is analyzed in a 360° ecosystem, with their own SWOT analysis and constant monitoring that enhances their ability to fulfill multiple roles on the field.



THE 5P CURVE

Mapping the future

How do we know where a player is headed? Through the **5P Curve**, an innovative and complex visual mathematical index, developed in-house, that allows us to trace each footballer's competitive cycle through five key stages, with 87% accuracy that increases as data intake grows:

P1

BASE

The player's starting point

P2

ASCENT

The growth curve

P3

PEAK

The maximum expected performance

P4

TODAY

The footballer's current state

P5

PROJECTION

At a 12-month horizon

MARKET INTELLIGENCE

We read any league on the planet

The Azulgrana Academy's commercial management no longer depends exclusively on offers received by the Club. The developed system enables permanent monitoring of leagues, clubs, affiliates, and youth divisions in any country, identifying concrete market needs and automatically matching them with our players' potential through the 5P Curve.



THE 4-STAGE PROCESS

- Scanning leagues, clubs, affiliates, and academies.
- Detection of specific needs (e.g.: "need a left-footed U-20 center forward").
- Automatic matching between the detected need and the player portfolio via the 5P Curve.
- Generation of a commercial opportunity with a complete dossier and USD valuation.

The analysis incorporates a compatibility thermometer with a scale of 8.0 out of 10, a six-dimension evaluation radar, and an anti-hallucination contract that guarantees the system never fills in non-existent information. When data is unavailable, the report explicitly states so.

WHAT WE BUILT

Eight domains, one single brain



The developed technology platform integrates eight areas that are usually commercialized by independent providers into a single ecosystem. Instead of relying on multiple isolated systems, the Club operates with a single platform specifically designed for the comprehensive management of the Academy.

THE 8 INTEGRATED DOMAINS

- **Sports Core:** technical direction, RTA methodology, and load management.
- **Video Analysis:** proprietary analysis engine through the M-025 system.
- **Player360:** player's single file and sporting valuation.
- **Health & Nutrition:** Medical Shield and monitoring through the 5P Curve.
- **Administration & Finance:** cash flow, procurement, and management under IFRS standards.
- **Commercial & Partners:** commercial pipeline and SROI measurement.
- **Ciclón AI:** intelligent orchestrator based on RAG technology.
- **CEAI Foundation:** management of educational programs and sponsorship.

The entire infrastructure operates on PostgreSQL together with Ciclón AI, forming a single technological core that centralizes all institutional information.

THE ABILITY TO DOCUMENT EVERYTHING

The reports the system produces today

Data-driven management requires the ability to document every process in a clear, verifiable, and professional manner. With that goal, the platform automatically generates reports both for on-screen consultation and in institutional PDF format, aimed at families, the coaching staff, the Club leadership, and potential market actors.

Currently, the system produces the following documents:

Player360 File

Comprehensive player file that brings together sporting, medical, academic, and personal data in a single verifiable document.

Commercial Dossier

Professional presentation document aimed at the international market, with performance metrics and projection.

Scouting Report

Structured evaluation of external players with tactical, physical, and squad integration potential analysis.

Psycho-emotional Profile and SWOT Analysis

Report focused on the footballer's comprehensive development, analyzing not only sporting performance but also personal and emotional aspects relevant to the development process. Intended exclusively for the coaching staff and the player's human support team.

Executive BI and Valuation

Executive report that brings together strategic indicators for institutional leadership. Includes: Ideal Team, SROI Indicators, and Platform Valuation compared to the international market.

Market Intelligence by League

Document that identifies commercial opportunities in foreign clubs, analyzes specific needs by position, and establishes matches between those demands and the Academy's footballers.

IT'S NOT A PROMISE: IT'S ALREADY UNDERWAY!

This is how our platform transforms the daily life of the Academy, area by area:

1. Health and Well-being

Top-level care



We care for our young players comprehensively. With the AI-powered Medical Shield, the system evaluates each clinical case and automatically alerts the Executive Director if the situation is urgent. Additionally, we unify medical, physiotherapy, psychological, and social data in one place, adding a Physiotherapy Traffic Light that gives us the exact moment for a safe return to the pitch and personalized 5P Nutrition plans integrated into each player's profile.

2. Sports Area

3. Video & Intelligence

World-class technology

We positioned ourselves at the forefront with world-class tools. We have a proprietary live video analysis engine that processes plays in real time and automatically cross-references them with official APF match reports. All of this is powered by Ciclón AI, our digital mind with 83 intelligent agents that analyze performance and market compatibility data to make better decisions.

4. Self-sustaining Academy

Management

We want to be closer to our people and protect the club. That is why personalized portals are already active for Mi Club (players), Families, and Sponsors. Institutionally, we safeguard the Azulgrana heritage with a commercial dossier that includes the USD valuation of 518 players and a Presidential BI dashboard that guarantees fully transparent control of our management.



TWO VALUES WORTH PUTTING INTO PERSPECTIVE

The greatest asset: The kids

Development is the club's engine. For the first time, we measure the kids' growth objectively. Today, the system registers 518 players with their updated USD market valuation and commercial dossiers ready. This work is already bearing fruit: we have 8 national team call-ups (U-15 to U-20) and an average of 2.66 points per match in youth divisions.



The path is clear: the player develops through the RTA Methodology, performs on the pitch, his value increases with every minute played, and when transferred, generates a direct return for the club. This is how our academy becomes a self-sustaining model.

What exactly is our technology platform?



Think of it as Cerro Porteño's "digital brain." It is a single virtual system that connects everything happening at the club. Instead of having medical data in a notebook, videos on a computer, and statistics in scattered files, this platform brings everything together in one place.

This way, the coaching staff, doctors, and directors all see the same interconnected information. If a kid improves his nutrition, the system shows in real time how it impacts his speed and how his injury risk decreases.

The competitive advantage

Globally, companies like STATSports (physical), Kitman Labs (health), or Hudl (video) charge fortunes to do just one of these tasks. Hiring them separately would be excessive and their data wouldn't communicate with each other. The Azulgrana Academy platform unites all those functions in a single ecosystem, saving us contracts and giving us a tool that rivals the best in Europe.



TOTAL TRANSPARENCY

Done, in progress, and what remains

Accountability also means showing what is still on the way. We do it with total honesty, because it is the best proof that our work is real. With pride, we close this period with 84% progress (232 deployments completed out of 275).

This is how we are organized today:

✓ ALREADY A REALITY

We consolidated key tools such as the Medical Shield, 6D Scouting and Player360, the Head Coach Space (with live analysts and APF data), the families and sponsors portal "Mi Club", the proprietary GPU-powered video engine, and the 5P Nutrition and Executive BI modules.

IN PROGRESS

We are making steady progress on the annual and historical table toward BI, the linking of physical identity and video, the tournament module (in validation), the strategic analysis of the First Division to establish the Academy's development priorities, and the automation of commercial scoring.

▶ NEXT CYCLE

To optimize resources amid concurrent tasks, we prioritized for the next stage the validation of the physiotherapy traffic light and the reconstruction of the valuation as a unified dashboard.

AT PARQUE AZULGRANA THERE IS A TEAM!

This first newsletter is not just a compilation of data and technological advances; it is the evidence of a cultural and administrative transformation in the Azulgrana Academy. When we took on the commitment to lead the Academy Project, we knew that Cerro Porteño's mystique and history demanded management worthy of its greatness: a structure sustained by auditable processes, innovation, and a transparent methodology. Today, the club's future is built day by day with order and certainty.

However, behind the artificial intelligence systems, the sporting metrics, and the rigor of the Medical Shield, the true foundation of this project is its human value. This Foundation rises and becomes self-sustaining thanks to the discipline, collective effort, and deep sense of belonging of the entire team.

Caring for life, developing well-rounded individuals, and empowering our young players' dreams is a task that involves all of us.
